

# 10th Annual Forum of the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region 2019 Let's meet in Gdańsk on June 12/13



**The main topic of the Forum is 'Circular and sharing economy as an answer to demographic changes and environmental challenges in the Baltic Sea Region.'**

The programme for the two-day event includes 19 seminars on a wide range of topics that supports the thematic focus of the Forum. During the seminars, you will be able to see the potential for the development of the Circular Economy in the Baltic Sea Region in areas such as health, food, tourism, transport, cities, bioeconomy, industry, education, migrants, labour, markets and demography.

Since 2010 a yearly Strategy Forum to support the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region has been organised. The purpose of the Strategy Forum is to communicate the implementation work of the Strategy and its objectives, to stimulate policy discussions in the region, to promote results and to provide stakeholders of the EUSBSR with networking opportunities.

The Annual Forum takes place in one of the eight EU member states in the Baltic Sea Region and aims to attract key stakeholders and active partners of the implementation of the EUSBSR from local, regional, national and EU level.

The 10th Annual Forum of the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region will be held in Gdańsk on 12-13 June, 2019. The Forum will be hosted by the Pomorskie Region, together with the Baltic Sea States Subregional Co-operation (BSSSC) under the Norwegian chairmanship, in close cooperation with the European Commission, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Poland and other partners. About 800 participants from governments, international organisations, NGOs, universities, local and regional administrations and businesses will gather to debate on trends and opportunities in the Baltic Sea Region.
